Key Vocabulary & Concepts

Judaism	The religion of the Jewish people
Hannukah (Chanukah)	Jewish festival of lights
Menorah	An special candlestick with 7 or 9 lights
Sukkot/Sukkah	Jewish festival celebrating gathering the harvest and God's protection in the desert Temporary shelter used for meals during Sukkot
David & Goliath	Story which reminds Jewish people that God can help them overcome anything
Tanakh	Whole Jewish Holy Book which includes 5 books of the Torah
Torah	The most important and Holy text in Judaism
