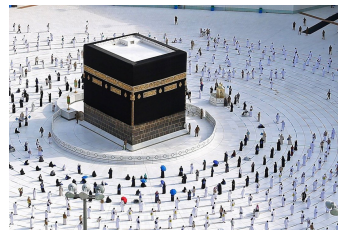
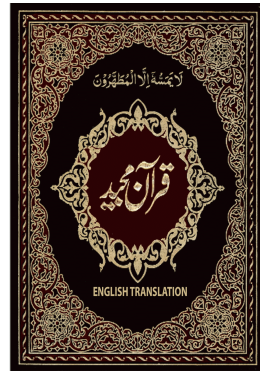


KS1 RE Knowledge Organiser: Who is Muslim and how do they live? Unit 1.6

Key Vocabulary & Concepts

Islam	The religion of Muslims.
Muslim	A follower of Islam.
Allah	Name for the Muslim one true God.
Five Pillars of Islam	Things Muslims must do to live a good life and be close to God
Shahada	A special prayer which reminds Muslims about the importance of God and Muhammad.
Tawhid	Belief that there is only one God.
Prophet	A messenger from God.
Muhammad	Founder of Islam who received messages from God.
Qur'an	Islamic holy book.

The Five Pillars of Islam

These are the five most important duties for Muslims.

<p>The Shahadah</p> <p>The belief that there is no God but Allah and that Muhammad is his messenger.</p>	<p>Salah</p> <p>Praying five times a day.</p>	<p>Zakat</p> <p>Making an annual charitable donation to help the poor.</p>	<p>Sawm</p> <p>Fasting during the month of Ramadan.</p>	<p>Hajj</p> <p>Attending the pilgrimage to Makkah once in your lifetime.</p>
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
