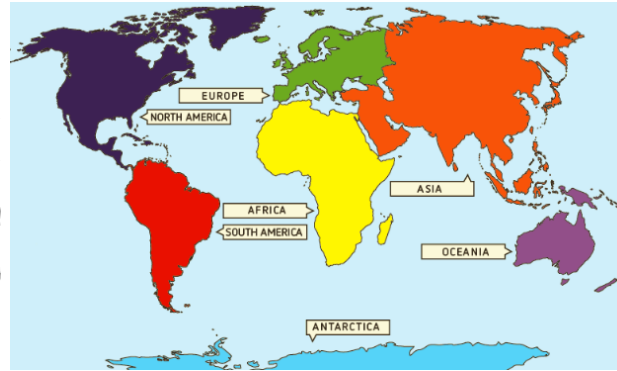


KS1 Geography Knowledge Organiser: Explorers - Continents and Oceans

Key Vocabulary

Continent	A very large area of land.	North & South Pole	The two points of the axis around which the planet rotates.
Ocean	A huge area of salty water.	Equator	An imaginary line around the centre of the planet.
Atlas	A book of maps.	Human features	Things made or built by humans (like cities, roads, farms).
Globe	A 3D spherical model of the Earth.	Physical features	Things that occur naturally (like seas, mountains, hills, valleys and rivers).
Hemisphere	One half of the globe.	Route	A way to get between places.
