

LKS2 R.E. L2.6 For Christians, what was the impact of Pentecost? (Kingdom of God)

Vocabulary

Pentecost	A Christian festival that takes place on the seventh Sunday after Easter and celebrates the sending of the Holy Spirit to the first followers of Jesus.
Trinity	The union of God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit in one God.
Holy Spirit	The spirit of God.
Resurrection	The rising of Jesus from the dead.
Disciples	The twelve special friends of Jesus.
Ascension	the <u>ascent</u> of Christ into heaven on the <u>fortieth</u> day after the Resurrection
Bible - New Testament	The second part of the Bible that tells about Jesus and the establishment of the Christian church
Kingdom of God	God's reign and rule on Earth and in heaven
Christianity	A religion based on the life of Jesus Christ, who Christians believe to be the Son of God

Ascension Day

- For 40 days after Easter Sunday, Jesus kept appearing to his disciples.
- The 40th day was the last time he did this before he was taken up to heaven.
- Christians call this the 'Ascension'.

Pentecost

- After the Ascension, Jesus' disciples were in a room when they heard a wind.
- Tongues of fire appeared on their heads and they could speak in different languages.
- They spread Jesus' word.
