Key Vocabulary & Concepts

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Geography	The study of places, the people that live in them and their environments.	The Tropics	The hotter regions of the Earth either side of the Equator.
Continent	One of the 7 large land masses on the Earth's surface.	Europe	The continent that the UK is in.
Population	The inhabitants of a place.	Equator	An imaginary line around the middle of the world.
Capital City	The city where a country's government is based.	UK	The United Kingdom of England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.
Ocean	A very large expanse of salt water that covers most of the Earth's surface.	The Poles	The north and south points (axis) around which the Earth rotates.
