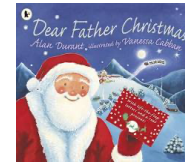

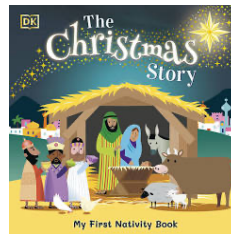

## Maths

Representing, comparing and composition of 1,2,3

Circles and Triangles – Identify in our environment, make pictures using different 2D shapes, identifying their different characteristics.

Representing numbers to 5, 1 more/1 less

Shapes with 4 sides.

Make repeating snake pattern

Make reindeer food – quantities to measure

## Literacy

Little Wandle Phonics – daily sessions

Reading 1:1 with the teacher

Range of books available in book corner and each carpet. Read The Colour Monster/Little Red Hen/The Nativity

Write CVC animal words linked to Little Red Hen.

Story map. How does she feel?

Handwriting Christmas cards – letter formation.

Write a shopping list of CVC words for a story character

## Physical Development

Activities to support fine motor skills – pegs, painting, chalking, drawing, writing

Handwriting and name writing (letter formation) daily. Daily Wake and Shake

Outdoor area accessible every day with open-ended materials (stacking/carrying/balancing)

Friday P.E. sessions focus on refining fundamental movement skills. Use apparatus to develop co-ordination, balance and agility.

## Expressive Arts and Design

Making poppies using red collage.

Colour mixing – add white to create lighter shades.

Learn the Nativity songs.

Make Christmas tree decorations.

Sing and perform in our Nativity.

Make Christmas cards for families.
