
- 1. Identify seasonal weather patterns in the UK and how these patterns affect us.

Poles	The northern and southern axis of the Earth.	Weather	What the sky and air outside are like.
Arctic	The region around the North Pole.	Climate	The average weather in a place over a number of years.
Antarctic	The region around the South Pole.	Seasons	The 4 different times of year with different types of weather.
Equator	An imaginary line around the middle of the Earth.	Observations	Noticing what happens over a period of time.
Tropics	The area of the planet either side of the Equator	Temperature	How hot or cold something is.
