Key Vocabulary

Latitude	Lines of latitude circle Earth parallel to the Equator.
Fairtrade	a worldwide movement that aims to help farmers and producers in less economically developed countries
Food miles	the distance food has travelled to get to your plate
Agriculture	Agriculture is another word for farming.
Economy	the way people spend money and the way people make money
Export	a product that is sold to people outside of the country in which the product was made.
Import	Something brought in from an exterior source, especially for sale or trade
Trade	buying and selling of goods and services.
