Fall	Adam and Eve giving in to temptation, and were banished from The Garden of Eden.	
Protector	Christians believe that God will bless, protect, heal, teach and make them a better person	
Sins	Christians believe that sin is the bad stuff people do that makes God sad and separates from him, often hurting us and other people
