



## Breakfast Club

### About our Breakfast Club

We seek to offer good quality childcare before school for the children of Alverton School. Our Breakfast Club team are all experienced members of staff who have completed DBS Safeguarding checks.

We aim to provide a stimulating and caring environment and a nutritious and filling breakfast which will prepare your child for the school day. We encourage the children to use Breakfast Club as a social opportunity and to participate in a range of play-based opportunities.

### Opening Times

Breakfast Club is open during term time from 7.45am to 8.30am from Monday to Friday (excluding INSET Days). Children can be dropped off or arrive at any time between these hours. Access to the Breakfast Club is via the main school entrance. If children would like to eat at Breakfast Club, they should arrive before 8.15am.

### Cost

The cost of Breakfast Club is **£3 per day** which is a sessional rate.

There is **no charge** for children who are in receipt of **Pupil Premium**.

Payment is required by the end of each week through Arbor Pay. We operate our Breakfast Club as a flexible 'pay as you use' provision which means that there is no need to book a place.

### What does Breakfast Club Offer?

We provide a range of unlimited food and we encourage all children to eat and drink something. Every day we offer:

- A choice of at least three different cereals
- Toast with a selection of spreads
- Fruit juice, milk (soya available on request) and water; hot chocolate in the winter
- Yoghurts

Occasionally, the menu is supplemented with different bakery goods, porridge and sausage baps. Where possible, any special diets will be catered for.
