

Art/D.T.

We will be creating still life compositions in colour, inspired by the work of Cezanne. We will also look at abstract art. Using charcoal, we will explore how to create light and shade. Our final outcome will be to create a memory box using our still life art work. For DT, we will be evaluating, designing and finally making a fabric bag.

PSHE

We will be exploring environmental issues and learning about the role trees play in supporting life on Earth and their importance in our lives. They will examine the effects of deforestation and learn how they can help to renew forests. After half term we will focus on money - its value, how to look after it and its effect on emotional wellbeing.

R.E.

We will be learning all about the Jewish religion. They will find out about the history of the religion, Jewish customs and beliefs and worship in the synagogue. We will reflect on the experience of Jewish people during the war.

Science

Children will learn about the properties of a range of materials, We will begin by studying the states of matter and then go on to perform experiments with dissolving, evaporation and reactions. This is a very hands-on and experimental unit.

English

Year 6 will be preparing for SATS. Year 5 will write a Friend or Foe WWII story and a newspaper report about The Battle of Britain. They will do instructional writing about what to do in an air raid and some WWII based poetry.

History

We will immerse the children in the history of this fascinating period and exploring how WWII impacted on our local community through a visit to Pendennis Castle. The children will learn all about the reasons for WWII and key events like Dunkirk, D-Day and The Battle of Britain. Alongside this we will explore what life was like for children during this period through a variety of challenges to do with rationing, black outs, air raids etc. The children will also have access to archived material that we will explore and use to examine local links.

Maths

In our maths lessons we will continue to follow the curriculum with a particular focus on mastery through applying and problem solving. Alongside this there will be many opportunities for WWII based maths challenges.

French

In French we will be learning about countries and festivals in the French speaking. We will also look at words and phrases related to maintaining a healthy lifestyle.

Computing

The children will start to create vector drawings, using different tools to create images. We will also develop our programming skills using micro:bits.
