Vocabulary	
Old/New Testament	Stories of the Bible. The Old Testament is before the birth of Jesus. The New Testament is the story of Jesus and after his death and rebirth.
Hymns	Songs about God or his son Jesus Christ that are usually sung collectively by Christians.
Prayer	A request or discussion that a person has with God. Usually asking for support, guidance or forgiveness.
Church	A place where Christians go to worship and celebrate God together. These are buildings made specifically for gathering together.
Promise	A deal that Christians have made to God.

- The story of the Lost Son which focuses on forgiveness and love from God.
- Christians worship to practice their faith to God.
- Creation is the beginning story of the Bible.


