We will be learning the vocabulary of pets, how to ask and answer questions about pets and say if they have or don't have a pet.

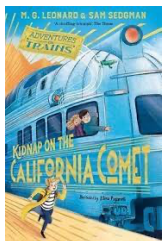
Our second unit focusses on school, learning subject and time vocabulary aiming for pupils to be able to say sentences describing what time they do a subject and if they like it.

North America



Geography

DT

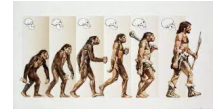
In DT we will be looking at the sustainability of ingredients and designing and making a bolognese.



English

Year 5 will be doing North American poetry, a non-chronological report on the Gold Rush, The Highwayman (narrative poem) unit and a story based on Beowulf legend.

Year 6 will be writing in lots of different genres, working to perfect their punctuation and sentence structure whilst producing work to put in their portfolios.



Science

In Science our first topic is Evolution and Adaptation, where we will be studying fossils and what we can learn from them, Charles Darwin and his theory of evolution, using the Galapagos Finches and how they have evolved as an example.

Our second unit is Animals including Humans where we learn about changes in our bodies as we grow old.



RE

Our first unit examines the story of the creation in Genesis, how Christians interpret this and contrast their beliefs to scientific theories about how the planet evolved. Our second unit compares Christians' beliefs to non-believers, looking at how this impacts on their lives.

Music

In Music we will be learning about movie music through the ages, exploring sound effect techniques and using our knowledge to compose our own movie music, following a time sheet. Our second half term will be a Charanga unit exploring the musical building blocks of Jazz music. We will also be preparing for our Christmas carol service.
