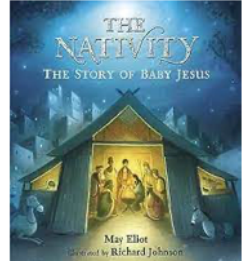

Maths
 Representing, comparing and composition of 1,2,3- Making posters of 1,2 and 3.
 Circles and Triangles- Identify in our environment, make pictures using different 2D shapes, identifying their different characteristics.
 Representing numbers to 5, 1 more/1 less
 Shapes with 4 sides.
 Patterns (Christmas)- making our own repeating pattern wrapping paper

Literacy
 Little Wandle Phonics – daily sessions
 Reading 1:1 with the teacher
 A range of books available in our book corner.
 The Colour Monster
 Write CVC animal words linked to Little Red Hen.
 Story map. How does she feel?
 Recall recipe ingredients
 Sequence the Nativity story
 Handwriting Christmas cards – letter formation.

Physical Development
 Activities to support fine motor skills
 Handwriting daily.
 Outdoor area accessible every day with open-ended materials (stacking/carrying/balancing)
 Friday P.E. sessions focus on refining fundamental movement skills.
 Use apparatus to develop co-ordination, balance and agility.
